Dear Mr. Mitchell:

The following information regarding fire protection in the Grindstone Provincial Recreation Park will be of interest to your members.

1. "No burning" policy during April 1st - November 15th will be strictly enforced.
2. All occupied lots should be cleared of any potential fire hazard material to minimize the potential for flash fire and also reduce the heat build up should a fire occur.
3. Additional signs will be erected stating "Open Fires Prohibited" in the Grindstone area entry road and the sub-divisions under development.'
4. During high fire hazard periods scheduled patrols will be carried out.
5. The flight path for the detection aircraft has been altered to improve the coverage over this area.
6. It is the intention to re-activate the manning of the present fire tower on Hecla Island during the 1982 fire season.

Basic fire fighting procedure training courses have been scheduled within the Hecla and Winnipeg Beach work crews and would be used for initial fire attack crews in the Grindstone area. Additional coverage would be brought in from the adjacent districts. In addition the water bombers presently based in Winnipeg and the helicopter from Bissett would be brought in to use if needed.

Additional coverage not presently available would require the installation of telephones in the cottaging area. This could be accomplished through direct negotiation between the Manitoba Telephone System and the Cottaging Association. With hydro now in the area of Black's Point this is now a possibility.

I trust the foregoing will assist to explain and outline the program for cottagers in the Park.

In the interest of assisting your members in the enjoyment of the Park, arrangements to meet with the Regional Manager for the Region, Mr. Joe Nespor to review any concerns could be arranged at a mutually convenient time. Please feel free to contact me should this be required.

## HYDRO UPDATE

As of September 22nd, 1981, there were 170 Blacks Point cottages which are now connected. Another ten are presently being wired and are expected to be connected prior to October 31st.

Based on our agreement with Manitoba Hydro wherein the Association agreed to guarantee the revenue from 208 "connects", the capital levy for each customer would be calculated as follows:

$$208 - 180 = 28 \times \$100 = \$2,800$$

$$\$2,800 \text{ divided by } 180 = \$15.56 \text{ each}$$

It now appears that another twenty cottage owners are working for a 1982 hookup. Of the 222 assigned lots in Blacks Point, 9 are not yet built, 180 will be connected this year, 20 next year and the remaining 13 belong to people who have been transferred out of the province.

With any luck, we should reach the magic number of 208 connects in 1982.
