Do your part to discourage crime.. show the Project Identification sticker on your windows.

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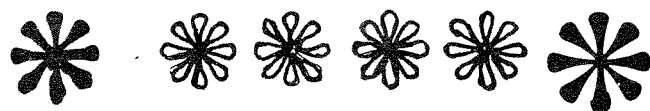

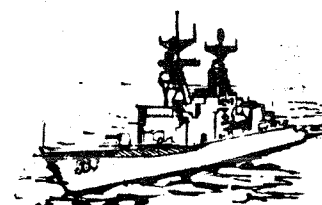

Expect to hear by early Spring whether the project has the go-ahead.

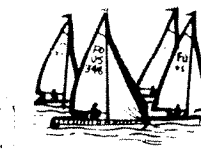
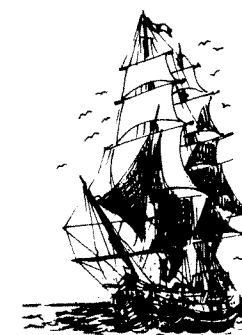
