

<b>1976</b>	First draw for cottage lots held for Black's Point, Phase I. 81 lots at a cost of \$1,200 with yearly lease fees of \$70 for lake front and \$40 for back tier lots.
<b>1977</b>	Draw for Black's Point Phase II lots
<b>1978</b>	Draw for Black's Point Phase III lots.
<b>1979</b>	Our first AGM. Membership dues were \$1.00 per year.
<b>1980</b>	Draw for 87 lots in Island View North & South and North Cliffs sub-divisions.
<b>1980/81</b>	Hydro became available to cottages in the Black's Point area
<b>1981</b>	First Annual Grindstone Days on August long weekend.
<b>1984</b>	Draw for South Beach lots
<b>1984</b>	Radio pay phone installed in Black's Point.
<b>1987</b>	Individual phone lines are available for cottages.
<b>1990's</b>	Black's Point loop trail was developed as a joint project between the cottagers and parks branch.
<b>1990's</b>	Fire Shed & equipment was set up and cottage owners trained in fire fighting. It is now located beside the General Store.
<b>1990's</b>	Little Grindstone Harbour Authority formed to operate the marina.
<b>1998</b>	Grindstone General Store was opened. It is owned and operated by Don & Sandy Bridges, cottage owners.
<b>2000</b>	Willow trail was developed as a joint project between the cottagers and Parks branch to establish a trail from Black's Point up to Little Grindstone Beach.
<b>2002</b>	Little Grindstone Beach play structure was installed another joint project.
<b>2008</b>	"Go Greener Grindstone" plan was adopted at our AGM to encourage cottagers to leave a smaller footprint on our environment.
<b>2008</b>	Garth Meacham completes a carving of a Woodland Spirit at the entrance to the cottage area at Black's Point.
<b>2009</b>	911 Service is now available in our park.
<b>2009</b>	Construction begins on a new sewage lagoon for Grindstone
<b>2009</b>	Grindstone Trails Committee enhances/grooms snowmobile trails on Grindstone and over to Hecla Island
<b>2010</b>	Grindstone Trails Committee builds warm-up shed for snowmobile/ski trails at mile 10
<b>2010</b>	August long week, Grindstone Days, to include a Manitoba Homecoming theme.
